Dear Mr. Mounsey:

On June 5, 2013, a Notice of Violation (NOV) was issued to MAK-J Energy Wyoming for the failure to obtain a permit and install control equipment at the Federal 4-22-20-92 production facility located in Sweetwater County, Wyoming. The new owner, Foundation Energy, upon taking over operations followed the permitting process and installed appropriate controls to remedy these violations. Through discussion with your company the Division received a letter dated June 24, 2013 explaining that MAK-J Wyoming is in the process of dissolution. It is also understood that all assets have been or are to be sold and the company is to be terminated by end of year.

With this information, the Division is satisfied that MAK-J and Foundation Energy has taken the necessary action to satisfactorily resolve the issues identified in the NOV. On that basis, the Division will not take any further action to refer the NOV to the Attorney General's Office nor will we pursue a monetary settlement amount for the NOV.
