RE: Notice of Violation

Dear Mr. Sims:

Enclosed you will find a Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to Western Wyoming Construction, Inc. by the Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division, for failing to comply with permit requirements at the gravel pit, crushing plant and asphalt plant located in Fremont County, Wyoming. These are violations of permits CT-4444 and RE-25. These violations were noted by DEQ Air Quality Engineers on September 6, 2013, October 22, 2013, November 1, 2013 and November 21, 2013.

As the Department and this Division consider the failure to comply with air quality permit conditions to be a serious matter, I am considering recommending the Department refer this violation to the State Attorney General's office requesting a suit be filed in District Court to recover appropriate penalties. If you would like to discuss settlement of this Notice of Violation prior to referral to the Attorney General's office, please contact Mr. Fred DiLella, Air Quality Compliance Manager, at 307-777-3774 no later than ten (10) days after receipt of this letter.
