RE: Notice of Violation

Dear Mr. Davis:

Enclosed you will find a Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to Ballard Petroleum Holdings, LLC by the Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division, for failure to permit the State 43-36 PH facility located in Campbell County, Wyoming. By failing to permit the facility, Ballard Petroleum Holdings, LLC has not followed the Oil and Gas Production Facilities Chapter 6, Section 2 Permitting Guidance and is in direct violation of the construction permitting requirements of Chapter 6, Section 2(a)(i) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations.

As the Department and this Division consider the failure to comply with air quality permitting requirements to be a serious matter, I am considering recommending the Department refer this violation to the State Attorney General's office requesting a suit be filed in District Court to recover appropriate penalties. If you would like to discuss settlement of this Notice of Violation prior to referral to the Attorney General's office, please contact Ms. Ann Shed, Air Quality Compliance Program Principal, at 307-777-8601 no later than ten (10) days after receipt of this letter.


each violation for each day during which the violation continues, a temporary or permanent injunction, or both a penalty and an injunction.
