

In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by EOG Resources, Inc. to construct the I-80 Compressor Station, to consist of two (2) 20.0 MMscfd tri-ethylene glycol (TEG) dehydration units equipped with 0.6 MMBtu/hr reboiler heaters, one (1) flare, two (2) 400 barrel (bbl) condensate storage tanks, one (1) 400 bbl produced water storage tank, and three (3) electric compressor motors. The I-80 Compressor Station is located in the SE¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 19, T14N, R64W, approximately thirteen (13) miles east of Cheyenne, in Laramie County, Wyoming.

For the duration of the public comment period, copies of the permit application, the agency's analysis, and the public notice are available for public inspection online at <http://deq.wyoming.gov/aqd/new-source-review/resources/applications-on-notice/> and at the Laramie County Clerk's Office, Cheyenne, Wyoming.
