

In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by BP America Production Company to operate three (3) 380 hp Cummins KTA19GC natural gas fired engines, three (3) 625 hp Caterpillar G398TA natural gas fired engines, one (1) 415 hp Caterpillar G379TA natural gas fired engine, one (1) 830 hp Caterpillar G399TA natural gas fired engine, one (1) 215 hp Caterpillar G3406NA natural gas fired engine, one (1) 255 hp Caterpillar G3408NA natural gas fired engine, and one (1) 330 hp Caterpillar G379NA natural gas fired engine at various oil and gas production facilities in Carbon and Sweetwater counties, Wyoming.
