

**In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by SM Energy Company to construct a sweet crude oil and natural gas production facility, known as the Roger Leo Federal 3875-20-29-1FH, with one smokeless combustion device to control volatile organic compounds and hazardous air pollutant emissions associated with the oil storage tanks, located in the NE1/4NE1/4 of Section 20, T38N, R75W, approximately twenty-seven (27) miles north of Glenrock, in Converse County, Wyoming.**
