

In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by Sinclair Transportation Company to modify the Cheyenne Station with the installation of one (1) 16,800 bbl external floating roof crude oil storage tank, one (1) 84,200 bbl internal floating roof crude oil storage tank and a new tank truck unloading system that includes a four (4) bay unloading rack and two (2) Lease Automatic Custody Transfer (LACT) units. The Cheyenne Station is located at 1500 Parsley Avenue, in Cheyenne, Laramie County, Wyoming.

For the duration of the public comment period, copies of the permit application, the agency's analysis, and the public notice are available for public inspection online at <http://deq.wyoming.gov/aqd/new-source-review/resources/applications-on-notice/> and at the Laramie County Clerk's Office, Cheyenne, Wyoming.
