

Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality PUBLIC NOTICE:
In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by J.P. Oil Company, Inc. to construct a new sour crude oil and natural gas production facility, known as the Buck Creek Commingling Tank Battery, with a common smokeless flare to control volatile organic compound and hazardous air pollutant emissions associated with the oil tanks, active produced water tanks and produced gas, located in the SE1/4NE1/4 of Section 18, T36N, R63W, approximately twenty-three (23) miles north of Lusk, in Niobrara County, Wyoming.
