

In accordance with Chapter 6, Section 2(m) of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations, notice is hereby given that the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality, proposes to approve a request by BP America Production Company to operate ten (10) portable compressor engines consisting of four (4) 380 hp Cummins KTA19GC natural gas fired engines, three (3) 325 hp Caterpillar G3406TA natural gas fired engines, one (1) 400 hp Caterpillar G3408TA natural gas fired engine, one (1) 145 hp Caterpillar G3306NA natural gas fired engine, and one (1) 203 hp Caterpillar G3306TA natural gas fired engine to be operated at oil and gas well sites at various locations in Sweetwater and Carbon Counties in Wyoming.
