

The southern boundary of the designation area follows the Big Sandy River East from the confluence of the Green River and the Big Sandy River to the confluence of the Little Sandy Creek. The boundary follows Little Sandy Creek to the confluence of Pacific Creek. Continue along Pacific Creek to the confluence of Whitehorse Creek. The boundary follows Whitehorse Creek until it nears the SE corner of Sublette County at which point it breaks off and connects to the corner of Sublette county(~1000ft).

From the confluence of the Green River and the Big Sandy River continue along Green River to the confluence of Fontenelle Creek; follow Fontenelle Creek to the confluence of Roney Creek. The boundary leaves the river and follows the watershed boundary between Fontenelle Creek/Bartlett Creek and Roney Creek until it meets the watershed boundary of the South Fork of Fontenelle Creek. The boundary follows the watershed boundary of S.F. Fontenelle Creek and Fontenelle Creek/Bartlett Creek for 8,075ft where the watershed boundary turns back to the east. At this point the boundary drops into the valley of the S.F. Fontenelle Creek and crosses the creek to the watershed boundary on the North side of the creek. The boundary follows the watershed boundary between Fontenelle Creek and S.F. Fontenelle Creek to the head water of Minnie Holden Creek. The boundary drops into the valley of Minnie Holden Creek and parallels the creek to the last bend before the confluence of Fontenelle Creek. Here the boundary makes an angle heading to the NE toward the SW corner of Sublette County 7,000ft.
