SUBJECT: Covid-19 Wyoming DEQ's Temporary Guidance on Enforcement and Compliance Assurance Programs: Termination

On April 10, 2020, I issued a memorandum entitled *Covid-19 Wyoming DEQ's Temporary Guidance on Enforcement and Compliance Assurance Programs*, a temporary policy regarding DEQ's exercise of enforcement of environmental legal obligations during the COVID-19 public health emergency.

The purpose of today's memorandum is to provide notification that the April 10, 2020 Temporary Guidance is being terminated effective at 11:59 PM Mountain Time, May 10, 2021.

Per the Temporary Guidance the DEQ will post this Memorandum of Termination on the DEQ website with the effective date of termination.

The termination of the guidance is appropriate at this time due to the decreasing number of active cases of COVID-19 and the availability of the vaccine within the State.

Nothing herein limits the ability of the DEQ to exercise enforcement discretion on a case-by-case basis regarding any noncompliance before or after the temporary policy is terminated.
