RE: Condition #7 of Exhibit 2- 90 Percent Completion Notice for Three Buttes Wind Project

Dear Dr. Schroeder,

Pursuant to Docket No. DEQ/ISC 08-04 and ISC Order dated April 3, 2009, Condition #7 states the following:

The Permittee shall give written notice to the ISD when the physical components of the Project are 90 percent complete.

Duke Energy is pleased to report that the physical components of Three Buttes LLC's Campbell Hill Windpower Project are 90% complete as of October 14, 2009. Currently, the 66 GE 1.5-MW turbines have been erected and are ready for commissioning. Additionally, the balance of the plant is complete, and the substation, O&M building, transmission line and roads are in order and ready for service. Remaining project construction activities include the back feed of power from the PacifiCorp substation (Latigo) to the substation at Campbell Hill, final commissioning the turbines, completion of punch list items, remaining reclamation activities, and construction demobilization.

Duke Energy would like to thank the Industrial Siting Division for its assistance in helping the project be constructed in compliance with the Wyoming Industrial Development Information and Siting Act statutes and rules. We look forward to our continued work with you as we complete the construction phase and enter the operational phase for the Campbell Hill Windpower Project.
