RE: Request for Amendment to Change the Model of the Turbines
Pioneer Wind Park I and Pioneer Wind Park II

Dear Mr. Esch:

Pursuant to Condition #11, Wasatch Wind Intermountain, LLC (hereinafter "Wasatch Wind") hereby requests approval for an amendment to change the model of the turbines for Pioneer Wind Park I and Pioneer Wind Park II (hereinafter "Projects").

In support thereof, Wasatch Wind will demonstrate that good cause exists for the amendment of the permit because of technological advancements with the turbines and changing market conditions. The requested amendment is in compliance with local ordinances and applicable land use plans and will not significantly add to adverse environmental, social and economic impact in the impacted area.

As permitted, the Projects used General Electric (hereinafter "GE") 1.6 xle 82.5 wind turbine generators. On June 24, 2013, Wasatch Wind obtained an amendment to change the wind turbine generators to a GE 1.85-82.5. General Electric recently notified Wasatch Wind that it is no longer manufacturing blades for the GE 1.85-82.5 wind turbines. Accordingly, the permitted turbines will not be commercially available for the Projects.

Wasatch Wind hereby requests approval for an amendment to its Permit to change the model of the turbines to the GE 1.85-87.

Wasatch Wind requests the proposed amendment be heard in accordance with Wyoming Statute § 35-12-106(c) at the next meeting of the Industrial Siting Council scheduled for Tuesday, October 1, 2013 in Wheatland, Wyoming.
