RE: Ten Day Notice's and Citizens Complaint – Peabody Energy's and Subsidiaries Mining Operations in Wyoming

Dear Mr. Wendtland:

On February 8, 2016, the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) received a Citizen Complaint from WildEarth Guardians. The complainant requested an inspection and enforcement action regarding ongoing surface coal mining operations of Peabody Energy and its subsidiaries Peabody Caballo Mining, LLC; Caballo Coal Company; Peabody Powder River Resources, LLC; and Peabody School Creek Mining, LLC. The complainant requested an inspection and enforcement action regarding ongoing surface coal mining operations of Peabody Energy and its subsidiaries. The complainant alleges a violation of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act (SMCRA) and states that they have reason to believe that Peabody Energy and its subsidiaries are conducting surface coal mining operations in Wyoming without sufficient reclamation bonding as required by SMCRA. Specifically, the complainant alleges that Peabody Energy is violating SMCRA's bonding requirements because the company and its subsidiaries no longer qualify for self-bond status. Additionally, the complainant alleges that Peabody Energy failed to notify your office that they no longer qualified for self-bonding, and to post an alternative bond within 90-days.

OSMRE believes it is most appropriate to forward the Citizen's Complaint to your office via the TDN process in order to provide the opportunity for you to respond to the allegations that the self-bonding requirements of the approved State Program are violated because the guarantor's assets are being used by the parent company as collateral for debt, and that Peabody Energy failed to notify you that they no longer qualified for self-bonding and post an alternative bond within 90-days. Therefore, in accordance with OSMRE's Directive System, INE-24 and INE-35, the CAO is herewith referring the complaint to your office (the Regulatory Authority) via the enclosed TDNs:

In addition to the TDN's, also enclosed are the CAO's Mine Site Evaluation Forms and TDN narrative. Please also reference the February 8th, 2016 Citizen Complaint letter and the February 11, 2016 Supplemental Information and Supplemental Complaint Filing that was hand delivered on February 12, 2016.

Please respond to the TDNs as directed in 30 C.F.R. § 842.11 within ten calendar days by taking appropriate action to cause the possible violations to be corrected, or to show good cause for such failure. Appropriate action and good cause are defined 30 C.F.R. § 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(3) and (4). Appropriate action includes enforcement or other action authorized under the State program to cause the violation to be corrected. Good cause includes showing that the possible violations do not exist under the approved State program, the State regulatory authority requires a reasonable and specified amount of additional time to determine whether a violation exists, the State regulatory authority lacks jurisdiction under its program over the possible violation or subject operation, the State regulatory authority is precluded by an administrative or judicial order from an administrative body or court of competent jurisdiction from acting on the possible violation where that order is based on the violation not existing or where temporary relief standards of section 525(c) or 526(c) of SMCRA have been met, or with regard to abandoned sites the State regulatory authority is diligently pursuing or has exhausted all appropriate enforcement provisions of the State program. These TDN's do not constitute written determinations under 30 CFR 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(1) of whether the standards for appropriate action or good cause have been met, and do not constitute notices of violation or cessation orders under 30 CFR Part 843. After your response, OSMRE will issue its written determination and, if necessary, will issue any necessary order to correct the violation, if found.

As a result of the information below, the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) has reason to believe that the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality-Land Quality Division (WYDEQ) may be allowing Peabody Caballo Mining, LLC; Caballo Coal Company; Peabody Powder River Resources, LLC; and Peabody School Creek Mining, LLC (collectively, Peabody Energy) to operate in violation of the Wyoming Approved State Program. Therefore, pursuant to 30 U.S.C. § 1271(a) and 30 C.F.R. § 842.11(b)(2), OSMRE is issuing the following Ten Day Notices (TDN's) for the following surface coal mining operations in Wyoming:

TDN #X16-010-549-010 – Permit #240-T7 (Rawhide Mine)
TDN #X16-010-549-011 – Permit #433-T7 (Caballo Mine)
TDN #X16-010-549-012 – Permit #477-T7 (Shoshone #1 Mine)
TDN #X16-010-549-013 – Permit #569-T8 (North Antelope Rochelle Mine (NARM))
TDN #X16-010-549-014 – Permit #764-T2 (School Creek Mine)

The Federal regulation at 30 C.F.R. § 842.11 provides that absent an imminent danger or harm scenario, OSMRE must issue a TDN to a Regulatory Authority (RA) when it has reason to believe a violation exists or when, on the basis of a Federal inspection, it determines that a violation exists (and OSMRE has not issued a previous TDN for the same violation). These TDN's are not based on Federal inspections, and OSMRE has not yet determined that violations exist. However, based on the allegations in the Citizen's Complaint summarized below, OSMRE has reason to believe that WYDEQ may be allowing Peabody Energy to operate in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Wyoming Act) and WYDEQ Coal Rules and Regulations by allowing Peabody Energy's Wyoming surface mining operations to continue to extract coal while failing to meet the criteria to qualify for self-bonding.

In accordance with the Wyoming Act and WYDEQ Rules and Regulations for Coal, surface mine operators may "self-bond" to cover the costs of reclaiming mine sites if the requisite criteria are satisfied. Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-417(d); Wyo. Admin. Code § ENV LQC Ch. 11 § 2(a)(vii)(A)-(C). In Wyoming, Peabody Energy is currently self-bonded at the following operations:

Rawhide Mine, Permit # 240-T7 (SBC141)
Caballo Mine, Permit #433-T7 (SBC142)
Shoshone #1 Mine, Permit # 477-T7 (SBC129)
North Antelope Rochelle Mine, Permit #569-T8 (SBC140)
School Creek Mine, Permit #764-T2 (SBC143)

On February 8, 2016, the OSMRE received a Citizen's Complaint from the WildEarth Guardians. The complainant requested an inspection and enforcement action regarding ongoing coal mining operations of Peabody Energy and its subsidiaries in Colorado, New Mexico, and Wyoming. The complainant alleges violations of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act (SMCRA), stating that they have reason to believe that Peabody Energy and its subsidiaries are conducting coal mining operations in these states without sufficient reclamation bonding as required by SMCRA. Specifically, the complainant alleges potential violations of self-bonding requirements due to the subsidiary guarantor's assets being pledged by the parent company as

collateral for debt, Peabody's credit rating having been downgraded below regulatory thresholds, Peabody's total liabilities to net worth ratio being greater than 2.5, Peabody's total amount of self-bonds exceeding 25% of its tangible net worth in the United States, and that Peabody failed to notify the WYDEQ that it no longer qualified for self-bonding and post an alternative bond within 90-days.

The Wyoming Act allows for self-bonding, as follows:

The council may promulgate rules and regulations for a self-bonding program for mining operations under which the administrator may accept the bond of the operator itself without separate surety when the operator demonstrates to the satisfaction of the director the existence of a suitable agent to receive service of process and a history of financial solvency and continuous operation sufficient for authorization to self-insure or bond this amount. This subsection shall not become operative until the council has promulgated rules and regulations for the self-bonding program which require that the protection provided by self-bonding shall be consistent with the objectives and purposes of this act.

Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-417.

To remain eligible for self-bonding, the Wyoming Land Quality Division Coal Rules and Regulations, Chapter 11, Section 4, require for renewal bonds, the submission of the following information:

(a) Information for the renewal bond under the self-bonding program which shall accompany the annual report shall include:

(i) Amount of bond required, which shall be determined in accordance with W. S. § 35-11-417(c)(ii). If the self-bond amount is proposed to be less than the full bond amount, the amount which is proposed is to be under a self-bond.

(ii) Financial information in sufficient detail to show that the guarantor still meets one of the criteria in Section 2(a)(vii), and the limitation in Section 2(a)(xii). The Administrator may request financial statements for the most recently completed fiscal year together with an independent certified public accountant's audit opinion or review opinion of the financial statements with no adverse opinion. Additional unaudited information may be requested by the Administrator.

(iii) If the Administrator has accepted a mortgage, any changes in evidence of value, title and possession of the property shall be submitted.

(iv) If the Administrator deems it necessary to value any asset, he may appoint the appraiser or appraisers mutually acceptable to the Administrator and the operator. Any such appraisal shall be expeditiously made, and a copy thereof furnished to the Administrator and the operator. The expense of the appraisal shall be borne by the operator. The findings of the appraisal shall be final and binding unless both

parties agree to a reappraisal.

(v) For coal operators using personal property as collateral to support a self-bond, the operator's current financial information showing continuing compliance with Section 3(c)(ii) of this Chapter.

(b) If the Administrator has authorized a parent corporate guarantee, the parent corporation shall supply all information required under subsection (a)(ii) of this Section.

(c) Any valid initial self-bond shall carry the right of successive renewal as long as the above listed information is submitted which demonstrates that the guarantor remains qualified under W.S. § 35-11-417(d).

Wyo. Admin. Code § ENV LQC Ch. 11 § 4.

The referenced financial information of Section 2 of the Coal Rules and Regulations includes:

For coal mining operations, financial information in sufficient detail to show that the operator meets one of the following criteria (the specific criterion relied upon shall be identified):

(A) The operator has a rating for all bond issuance actions over the past five years of "A" or higher as issued by Moody's Investor Service, Standard and Poor's Corporation or any other nationally recognized rating organization that is acceptable to the regulatory authority. Any additional rating organization must be a "nationally recognized statistical rating organization" as approved by the Securities and Exchange Commission. If the additional rating organization uses a different rating system, only ratings that are equivalent to a rating of "A" or higher by either Moody's Investor Service or Standard and Poor's Corporation will qualify (the rating organization should be identified together with any further breakdown of specific ratings).

(B) The operator has a tangible net worth of at least 10 million dollars, and a ratio of total liabilities to net worth of 2.5 times or less, and a ratio of current assets to current liabilities of 1.2 times or greater. The two ratio requirements must be met for the past year, and documented for the four years preceding the past year. Explanations should be included for any year where the ratios fall below the stated limits.

(C) The operator's fixed assets in the United States total at least 20 million dollars, and the operator has a ratio of total liabilities to net worth of 2.5 times or less, and a ratio of current assets to current liabilities of 1.2 times or greater. The two ratio requirements must be met for the past year and documented for the four years preceding the past year. Explanations should be included for any year where the ratios fall below the stated limits.

(D) If the operator chooses (B) or (C), the two ratios shall be calculated with the proposed self-bond amount added to the current or total liabilities for the current year. The operator may deduct the costs currently accrued for reclamation which appear on the balance sheet.

Wyo. Admin. Code § ENV LQC Ch. 11 § 2(a)(vii)(A)-(D).

OSMRE believes it is most appropriate to forward the Citizen's Complaint to the WYDEQ via the TDN process in order to provide the opportunity for WYDEQ to respond to the allegations that the self-bonding requirements of its approved State program are being violated. WildEarth Guardians alleges potential violations of self-bonding requirements due to the deterioration of Peabody's financial health, as explained above. Therefore, OSMRE is issuing the following TDN's:

WYDEQ may respond to these notices as directed in 30 C.F.R. § 842.11 within ten calendar days by taking appropriate action to cause the possible violations to be corrected, or to show good cause for such failure. Appropriate action and good cause are defined 30 C.F.R. § 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(3) and (4). Appropriate action includes enforcement or other action authorized under the State program to cause the violation to be corrected. Good cause includes showing that the possible violations do not exist under the approved State program, the State regulatory authority requires a reasonable and specified amount of additional time to determine whether a violation exists, the State regulatory authority lacks jurisdiction under its program over the possible violation or subject operation, the State regulatory authority is precluded by an administrative or judicial order from an administrative body or court of competent jurisdiction from acting on the possible violation where that order is based on the violation not existing or where temporary relief standards of section 525(c) or 526(c) of SMCRA have been met, or with regard to abandoned sites the State regulatory authority is diligently pursuing or has exhausted all appropriate enforcement provisions of the State program. These TDN's do not constitute written determinations under 30 C.F.R. § 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(1) of whether the standards for appropriate action or good cause have been met, and do not constitute notices of violation or cessation orders under 30 C.F.R. Part 843. After WYDEQ's response, OSMRE will issue its written determination and, if necessary, will issue any necessary order to correct the violations, if found.



