NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. Notice of Violation is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. §35-11-701(c)(i) which requires that a written notice shall be issued in the case of failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation.
2. On May 16, 2008 and November 16, 2007 inspections of Douglas Shaw's jade claims and small "mined" areas operated under the Small Mine Permit (SMP) Nos. 224Cs (i.e., issued on November 26, 1974; 5 claims) and 593s (i.e., issued on December 19, 1986; 1 claim) were conducted by Steve Platt of the Land Quality Division, District 2 Office. The SMP areas (i.e., claims) were located in the below named legal descriptions in southeast Fremont County.



3. On May 16, 2008 an inspection of Permit 224Cs was conducted by Steve Platt which revealed that there has been no mining or reclamation activity since the previous inspection conducted on August 24, 1989. On November 16, 2007 an inspection of Permit 593s was conducted by Steve Platt which revealed that there has been no mining or reclamation activity since the previous inspection conducted on August 24, 1989. In addition, no activity has occurred on any of the 6 areas since at least 1991.
4. The abandonment of the 2 mine permits and failure to commence reclamation after mining operations have ceased is a violation of W.S. §35-11-415(b)(iii).
5. The violations have not been corrected or remedied, nor has the operator provided any information to the Land Quality Division concerning the violations.
6. W.S. § 35-11-901(a) provides that any person who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act or any rule, standard, permit, license or variance adopted there under is liable for a penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for each day of violation, which penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming.

**NOTHING IN THIS NOTICE** shall be interpreted to in any way, limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this Order be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
