

Dear Mr. Lindley:

As you know, Lindley Construction, Inc. was issued a Notice of Violation, Docket No. 4681-10, on May 7, 2010 for conducting an unpermitted mining operation on the Danielson Ranch southeast of Evanston.

The site was inspected on June 19, 2012 with Mr. Ezola of your office. It was found that all mining disturbances have been properly reclaimed. Several small pit run stockpiles were left intact for the future private use of the landowner.

On July 18, 2012, I inspected the area with the landowner, Ms. Bregeeta Danielson. She indicated her satisfaction with the completed work and provided me with a signed Landowner's Statement of Satisfactory Reclamation the following day. My inspection report summarizing these findings is attached for your files.
