

**RE: Termination of Notice of Violation Docket No. 4516-09
Hebdon Construction, Limited Mining Operation No. 559ET**

Dear Mr. Hebdon:

Hebdon Construction was issued a Notice of Violation, Docket No. 4516-09, on June 29, 2009 for Mining in excess of 10 acres, failure to salvage topsoil, failure to post the required permit sign, failure to submit Annual Reports, and failure to post sufficient bond as required by the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act.

Following issuance of the NOV, a meeting was held on site to discuss a negotiated settlement agreement. With the submittal of the required Annual Reports, receipt of additional bonding, posting of a compliant permit sign, permitting (through the SEO) of a permanent post mining impoundment of 0.73 acres and reclamation of 1.55 acres of the north highwall, the terms of the agreement (un-signed) have been satisfied sufficiently to terminate the Notice of Violation.

Please be advised that the above-referenced Notice of Violation is hereby terminated. If you should have any questions regarding this correspondence, please feel free to call.

No additional lateral disturbance may occur under the Limited Mining Operation 559ET. If the operator desires to expand the mine, a small mine permit must be secured.
