



Abandoned Drill Site Reporting Requirements:

As required by W.S. §35-11-404(d) and (e) and under the authority of W.S. §35-11-110(a)(x), a report, in duplicate, containing the information indicated below will be submitted to the Land Quality Division and the State Engineer within twelve months\* after the drill holes have been capped, sealed, and/or plugged:

- a. Name and address of operator.
- b. Drilling Notification Number.
- c. Original USGS Quad or other maps of adequate detail depicting the following:
  1. Outline of the general area of activity.
  2. Approximate location of any constructed access roads, temporary roads, and drill hole locations.
- d. A tabulated listing of the drill holes showing:
  1. The locations of each drill hole, utilizing Wyoming state plane coordinates, (or to the nearest 200 feet for artesian holes).
  2. The total depth of each drill hole.
  3. Method of capping, sealing and/or plugging for each drill hole.
  4. Indicate surface ownership (Federal, State, or Private) for each drill hole location.
- e. Description of the nature and extent of disturbances, and a description of the reclamation of those locations indicated in c. above.
- f. Tabulation of the following:
  1. Seed mixture used.
  2. Method and date of seeding.
  3. Location(s) where seed mixture was used.
- g. If any item does not apply indicate by "N/A". A summary must also be included indicating why these items do not apply.

\* Note that this report is due within 60 days of the completion of an artesian hole.
