



NOTICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT ACTIVITIES

WDEQ Orphan Site Remediation Program

The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Orphan Site Remediation Program (WDEQ/OSRP) plans to conduct an environmental investigation of the Laramie 3rd Street Tetrachloroethene (PCE) Plume Orphan (Site). The Site is located in downtown Laramie and the investigation areas encompasses approximately 61 acres as shown on the back page of this notice. Concentrations of PCE in groundwater have been previously detected at levels exceeding the federal maximum contaminant levels (MCLs). Current conditions at the Site are unknown.

The initial investigation will include the following activities:

- Installation of temporary borings and collection of soil and groundwater samples
- Installation and sampling of permanent groundwater monitoring wells
- Installation and sampling of shallow soil vapor monitoring points

The purpose of the investigation is to determine the extent and nature of PCE in groundwater, soil, and soil vapor. The data will then be used to determine if additional investigation activities are necessary and to evaluate if soil vapor is potentially impacting indoor air. Once the impacts of the PCE are delineated, the WDEQ/OSRP will determine if cleanup and/or mitigation measures are necessary.
