The source(s) for the PCE is currently unknown.

In 1998, an environmental consulting firm conducted a Phase II environmental assessment on a vacant parcel at 851 N. 3rd Street during investigative activities associated with the LAUST Corrective Action Program. Three soil borings were drilled and groundwater sampled from each boring for volatile organic compounds. PCE was detected in all three groundwater samples, with concentrations ranging from 3.1 µg/L to 10.3 µg/L. Current conditions are unknown, and historical information is very limited.

In order to provide the OSRP with a current Phase I and Phase II, likely to include soil, groundwater and soil vapor sampling and analysis, and an accurate site conceptual model for the project area, the OSRP has provided the following documents:
