NOTICE OF VIOLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. On June 27, 2007, Mr. Charles Plymale of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ), conducted an inspection of Sinclair Wyoming Refining Co. for the purpose of evaluating compliance with the Wyoming Hazardous Waste Rules and Regulations (HWRR).
2. During the June 27, 2007 inspection the following violation was found:

Count 1. HWRR, Chapter 8, Section 3(e)(ii), requires that a hazardous waste generator who accumulates hazardous waste for more than 90 days is an operator of a hazardous waste storage facility and must therefore, obtain a hazardous waste permit unless the generator has been granted an extension by the department to the 90 day accumulation period. Sinclair Wyoming Refining Company had two roll off containers that exceeded the 90 day accumulation limit. A 30 day extension was obtained when the refinery was unable to meet the ninety (90) day accumulation time limit. Hazardous waste accumulation in the two containers then exceeded the additional 30 day extension by 3 days. Manifest number 002513021 and manifest number 002513019, verify the containers were onsite for 123 days each.


ANY PERSON who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act, or any rules, standard, permit, license, or variance adopted thereunder is liable to a penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each day of violation, which penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming; and

THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION is being sent to you pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-11-701(c) which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible.
