NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division issued a Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number 4434-09, to Ned Hurley and Fire Island Holdings, Inc. The Notice described certain activities and conditions at Pub Place C-Store, 4125 South Highway 89, Jackson, Wyoming, alleged to be in violation of the Environmental Quality Act and Water Quality Rules and Regulations. The Order prescribed corrective actions to be taken. Ned Hurley and Fire Island Holdings, Inc. did not appeal the notice of violation and order, and the order became final.

This was a red-tagging order issued under Chapter 17, Section 44, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. The red-tag was lifted by letter dated March 5, 2009, when Ned Hurley and Fire Island Holdings, Inc. complied with the major conditions of the order. Ned Hurley and Fire Island Holdings, Inc. have complied with the conditions in Docket Number 4434-09, and through monitoring and evaluation, DEQ, finds that all terms of the Order have been satisfied.
