NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE


The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division issued a Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number 4429-09 to Jackson Lumber Company. The Notice described certain activities and conditions at Jackson Lumber Company, 130 South Gros Ventre, Jackson, Wyoming, alleged to be in violation of the Environmental Quality Act and Water Quality Rules and Regulations. The Order prescribed corrective actions to be taken. Jackson Lumber Company did not appeal the notice of violation and order, and the order became final.

This was a red-tagging order issued under Chapter 17, Section 44, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. The red tag was lifted by letter dated March 27, 2009. Jackson Lumber Company has complied with the conditions in Docket Number 4194-07, and through monitoring and evaluation, DEQ, finds that all terms of the Order have been satisfied.
