NOTICE OF VIOLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

1. On August 30, 2010, Department personnel, Gary Keene and Charles Plymale, conducted an inspection of the Uinta County, Evanston #2 landfill (10.656) for the purpose of evaluating compliance with the Wyoming Solid Waste Rules and Regulations (SWRR). During the 8/30/2010 inspection, the following violations were found:

Count 1: The facility has not adequately controlled run-off to prevent ponding and surface water contact with wastes. [SWRR, Chapter 2, Section 4(i), 5(u)]. This is a repeat violation from inspections performed by WDEQ/SHWD personnel on July 8, 2009, July 28, 2009, March 2, 2010 and June 29, 2010.

Count 2: Cover for the landfill has not been placed according to the frequency and application requirements. [SWRR, Chapter 2, Section 5(q)]. This is a repeat violation from inspections performed by WDEQ/SHWD personnel on July 8, 2009, July 29, 2009 and March 2, 2010.

Count 3: The facility has not adequately posted the required signs at the facility access points. [SWRR, Chapter 2, Section 4(c)].

Count 4: The operator has not maintained adequate records for waste sold and/or salvaged from the landfill. [SWRR, Chapter 2, Section 5(y)(i)(D)].

Count 5: The required trench specification records are not being kept. [SWRR, Chapter 2, Section 5(y)(ii)(G)]. This is a repeat violation from the March 2, 2010 and June 29, 2010 inspections performed by WDEQ/SHWD personnel.

Count 6: Trench completion dates and/or contents are not adequately recorded. [SWRR, Chapter 2, Section 5(y)(ii)(H)].


2. On May 13, 2010, WDEQ/SHWD issued an NOV to Uinta County for similar violations of the SWRR at the Evanston #2 landfill. On June 29, 2010, and on August 30, 2010, inspections were conducted by SHWD personnel at the Evanston #2 landfill as a follow up to issuance of the NOV. The results of the inspections indicated that the violations listed in the NOV had not been corrected.




3. ANY PERSON who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act, or any rules, standard, permit, license, or variance adopted thereunder, is liable to a penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each day of violation, which penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming; and

4. THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION is being sent to you pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-11-701(c) which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy any alleged violation the Director of the Department of the Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible.
