Dear Mr. Eiden:

On November 1, 2012, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) issued Notice of Violation (NOV) and Order, Docket Number 4879-11, to Galen Eiden, located at Highway 189 Pinemar Subdivision, Marbleton, Wyoming. The NOV ordered Galen Eiden, to bring the Above Ground Storage Tanks (ASTs) located at Midway Mall Truckstop into compliance with Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR), Chapter 17.

Since NOV Docket Number 4879-11 was issued, Galen Eiden, has complied with the contents of the NOV and has completed the requirements to develop a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plan (SPCC) at Midway Mall Truckstop and submitted it to the DEQ. Therefore, Galen Eiden is in full compliance with WWQRR, Chapter 17 at this time.

Galen Eiden, has fully complied with the conditions in NOV Docket Number 4879-11, and through monitoring and evaluation, the DEQ finds that all terms of the Order have been satisfied.
