

NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Solid & Hazardous Waste Division (SHWD), issued Notice of Violation Docket Number 4819-11 on March 28, 2011 to the Town of Lyman. The alleged violations were disposal without a permit or one-time authorization [SWRR, Chapter 1, Section 1(f)], conducting the prohibited act of open dumping [SWRR, Chapter 1, Section 1(h)(i)], and conducting the prohibited act of open burning of wastes [SWRR, Chapter 1, Section 1(h)(v)].

Based on the DEQ site inspection and the information (disposal receipts and photo documentation) provided by The Town of Lyman dated April 6, 2012, all related solid waste material have now been properly removed from the Maxwell Ranch and properly transported and disposed to permitted facilities offsite. Therefore, The Town of Lyman has properly corrected the violation listed under Notice of Violation Docket Number 4819-11.
