

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (DEQ) and Maverik, Inc., enter into this Settlement Agreement to fully and finally resolve without litigation the violations alleged in Notice of Violation No. 5144-13, dated April 5, 2013. Maverik, Inc., is the owner and operator of the underground storage tanks (USTs) at Maverik #187, which is located at 425 South Sixth, Thermopolis, Wyoming. This UST facility is registered with the DEQ as facility 0-001526. The Notice of Violation alleges that Maverik, Inc., had: 1) failed to have an overfill prevention device, and 2) failed to have a drop tube. These are violations of Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 17.

W.S. 35-11-901(a)(ii) authorizes the DEQ to negotiate a stipulated settlement, including payment of a penalty, in lieu of litigation. To that end, Maverik, Inc., and the DEQ hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The DEQ is responsible for enforcing the Wyoming Storage Tank Act of 2007.
2. Maverik, Inc., committed the following violation of Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR), Chapter 17:

Count 1: Failure to Have an Overfill Prevention Device [WWQRR, Chapter 17, Section 6(c)(i)(B)]. As the owner and operator of the unleaded UST located at Maverik #187, Maverik, Inc., violated WWQRR, Chapter 17, Section 6(c)(i)(B), by failing to have an overfill prevention device.

Count 2: Failure to Have a Drop Tube [WWQRR, Chapter 17, Section 16(a)(iv)]. As the owner and operator of the unleaded UST located at Maverik #187, Maverik, Inc., violated WWQRR, Chapter 17, Section 16(a)(iv), by failing to have a drop tube that extends to within 6 inches of the bottom of a UST that is being monitored by inventory control.

3. The total penalty for the cited violations shall be one thousand, two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00). Maverik, Inc., agrees to pay a total of one thousand, two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) to the DEQ as a stipulated penalty for the cited violation. Payment of one thousand, two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) shall be made and returned with this Settlement Agreement. Payment shall be by check made payable to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality and addressed to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Attention: Oma Gilbreth, Herschler Building, 4th Floor West Wing, 122 W. 25th Street, Cheyenne, WY 82002.
4. Maverik, Inc.'s, full compliance with the terms of this Settlement Agreement shall constitute satisfaction for all claims by the DEQ against Maverik, Inc., based on the violations alleged in Notice of Violation Docket Number 5144-13. Contingent upon Maverik, Inc.'s, compliance with the terms of this Settlement Agreement, the DEQ will refrain from taking further enforcement action against Maverik, Inc., for these particular violations.
5. Maverik, Inc., waives any statute of limitations that may apply to an enforcement action by the DEQ involving the specific matters described in Notice of Violation Docket Number 5144-13 in the event that Maverik, Inc., fails to fulfill its obligations under this Settlement Agreement.
6. This Settlement Agreement shall be admissible by either party without objection by the other party in any subsequent action between these parties.
7. Each party shall bear its own attorney fees and costs, if any, incurred through the date this Settlement Agreement is signed by both parties.
8. This Settlement Agreement is binding upon Maverik, Inc., and all its successors and assigns and upon the DEQ.
9. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement supersedes any provision found in any Wyoming state law, or any regulation issued by the Department of Environmental Quality, or any federal law or regulation.



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10. The persons signing this Settlement Agreement certify that they are duly authorized to bind their respective parties to this Settlement Agreement.
