Dear Mr. Erickson:

Thank you for your recent payment for past due tank fees and thank you for performing an operator's annual inspection at the above mentioned facility. Because you have paid the past due fees, you have now complied with the Order outlined in Notice of Violation (NOV) Docket Number 4477-09. Therefore, the Fuel Delivery Prohibition Order that was included in the NOV is now lifted, and the DEQ Storage Tank Program (STP) considers this NOV resolved.

Once you order for fuel for this facility, you will have 90 days to obtain a licensed storage tank operator for the facility. This person will be required to take and pass the International Code Council (ICC) W-6 Wyoming Storage Tank Operator's Exam. Once they receive confirmation that they have passed the exam they will have to submit a license application to the DEQ STP.
