Dear Mr. Wright, Mrs. Wright, and Mr. Reach:

I would like to thank Mr. and Mrs. Wright for submitting proof that all of the required upgrades have been completed on the AST located at the Kendall Valley Lodge and for submitting documentation that an operator's annual inspection (OAI) has been performed. I would also like to congratulate Mrs. Wright for obtaining her Wyoming Class A Storage Tank Operator's License.

Because you have completed all of these tasks, you have now complied with the Order outlined in Notice of Violation (NOV) Docket Number 4783-10. Therefore, the Fuel Delivery Prohibition Order that was included in the NOV is now lifted, and the DEQ Storage Tank Program (STP) considers this NOV resolved.

Please be aware that once you receive fuel you will be required to perform inventory control, perform monthly interstitial monitoring, pay the required annual tank fees, and perform an OAI each year.
