

**The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality
Water and Waste Advisory Board Meeting**

The Wyoming Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) will meet on July 25, 2014 at 9:00 AM in Room UU415, University of Wyoming at Casper College, 125 College Drive, Casper, Wyoming. The public is invited to attend. Opportunity to comment on proposed rules presented to the WWAB for its consideration will be provided.

Water Quality Division- Beginning at 9AM the Water Quality Division (WQD) will present proposed revisions to Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 2, Permit Regulations for Discharges to Wyoming Surface Waters and Chapter 6, Salinity Standards, Criteria for the Colorado River Basin. WQD will request that the WWAB consider the proposed revisions and make a recommendation of adoption to the Environmental Quality Council. The objective of the proposed revision is to streamline WQD's Rules and Regulations by moving regulations from Chapter 6 to Chapter 2, new appendix O, and by removing redundant passages. Written comments regarding the proposed changes to Chapters 2 and 6 may be directed to Bill DiRienzo, DEQ/WQD, Herschler Building 4-W, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002, (307) 777-7081. Email comments will not be included in the public record.

Following the presentation of Chapters 2 and 6, WQD will present proposed revisions to Chapter 25, Small Wastewater Systems and Chapter 15, Standards for the Use or Surface Disposal of Biosolids. WQD will request that the WWAB consider the proposed revisions and make a recommendation of adoption to the Environmental Quality Council. This presentation will include the proposed rule with changes that have been incorporated based on the comments received during the April 18, 2014 WWAB meeting. Following the Chapter 25 presentation, WQD will present proposed revisions to Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 11, Design And Construction Standards for Sewerage Systems, Treatment Works, Disposal Systems or Other Facilities Capable of Causing or Contributing to Pollution and Mobile Home Park and Campground Sewerage and Public Water Supply Distribution Systems and Chapter 21, Standards for the Reuse of Treated Wastewater. WQD will request that the WWAB consider the proposed revisions and make a recommendation of adoption to the Environmental Quality Council. The objective of the proposed revision is to streamline WQD's Rules and Regulations by moving Chapter 21 to Chapter 11, new part H and by removing redundant passages. Solid and Hazardous Waste Division- At the conclusion of the WQD presentations, the WWAB will consider, discuss, and make recommendations regarding proposed revisions to Hazardous Waste Rules and Regulations (HWRR), Chapters 1 through 14. The proposed revisions to Chapters 1 through 14 use Incorporation By Reference (IBR) of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, "Protection of the Environment" (40 CFR). DEQ has shortened the existing 2008 HWRR from ca. 1,300 pages to a single chapter totaling 52 pages. The proposed changes to the HWRR clearly detail which parts of the 40 CFR have not been adopted by reference. Additionally, the proposed changes to the HWRR contain an appendix (Appendix A), which provides a detailed list of the more stringent provisions for the State relative to 40 CFR, as well as two additional tables which show the correlation between the previous rules and the 40 CFR/Federal statutes. The majority of the sections in the proposed HWRR are designed to

correspond to equivalent sections of the 40 CFR. The Statement of Principal Reasons (SOPR) explains in detail those obsolete provisions which have been omitted from the proposed HWRR, as well as the new parts of the 40 CFR which are being adopted as part of the proposed rules. Following the Hazardous Waste Rules presentation, the WWAB will consider a revised draft guideline on "Annual Reports for Municipal Solid Waste Landfills with Lifetime Permits". The Department will provide updates on the status of the Municipal Solid Waste Facilities Cease and Transfer Program. The WWAB will conclude by considering, discussing, and making recommendations regarding grant requests for reimbursement to local governments conducting solid waste landfill monitoring pursuant to W.S. 35-11-521 for the Solid and Hazardous Waste Division.
