

Notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division, Storage Tank Program (STP) is accepting applications for prequalification for excavation contractors, remediation system construction contractors, and equipment suppliers for remediation projects that will be constructed during 2015-2016. Excavation contractors, construction contractors, and equipment suppliers desiring to perform work for the STP must complete a prequalification application and questionnaire and submit the required forms to the STP for approval. Applications, forms, and information can be found on the STP website at: <http://deq.state.wy.us/shwd/stp> by clicking on the "Prequalification Applications" link. Contractors must be prequalified as of the date of the call for bid notice in order to be eligible to bid on a project. Excavation typically includes contaminated soil removal/disposal, backfill, and surface restoration. Remediation system construction may include pipeline and well installation, concrete foundation for system enclosures, excavation and soil disposal, contaminated groundwater and soil disposal, setting enclosures (provided by an equipment supplier) on the foundation, surface restoration and startup. Equipment supply may include providing equipment and enclosures, telemetry, delivery, and startup. OSHA 40-hour Hazwopper training is required for all personnel on site. Construction contractors and equipment suppliers must have experience in constructing, installing, and providing hydrocarbon contaminated soil and groundwater remediation equipment to become prequalified to complete this work. The following projects are scheduled for 2015 construction: Albany County 2, South Casper, Lander/Hudson, Dubois, Shoshoni/Lysite, and East Casper. For further information, contact Ms. Karen L.
