

In accordance with W.S. 9-2-1030, the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Solid & Hazardous Waste Division, Storage Tank Program (STP), hereby provides notice that solicitation for professional engineering services is ongoing for remediation projects. STP remediation projects address contamination of both soil and groundwater caused by leaking aboveground and/or underground storage tank systems that contained leaded and unleaded gasoline, diesel fuel, and used motor oil. In general, services for STP projects involve investigation of the sites, design of remedial alternatives, system construction management, system operation and maintenance, and decommissioning. On-site personnel must have 40-hour HAZWOPPER training with current 8-hour refresher course. Minimum insurance includes \$500,000 errors & omissions and \$1 million general liability. To be considered, a firm must submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ). The submittal package and instructions can be found at [www.deq.state.wy.us/shwd/STP](http://www.deq.state.wy.us/shwd/STP) by clicking on the "Prequalification Applications" link under the "Remediation" heading and selecting "Requirements for Statement of Qualifications for Professional Services." SOQs can be submitted at any time.

In accordance with W.S. 9-2-1031, the STP is notifying environmental consultants that the following projects will be out for Statements of Interest (SOI) in fall of 2014 and calendar year 2015: SE Wyoming, East Casper, Shoshoni/Lysite, Teton County 2, Carbon County, and Star Valley/Cokeville. In order to receive an SOI request, the firm must be on the prequalified list as of the date of the SOI.
