	Chap. 1 279 (279.70)(a)(1)&(2)	<u>APPLICABILITY. Any person who conducts the following activities is subject to the requirements of this section: A) Directs shipment of off-spec used oil to a used oil burner or B) First claims the used oil to be burned for energy recovery meets the used oil fuel specifications under HWRR 279.11. [See 279.70(b) for a listing of those persons that are not marketers]</u>
	1 279 (279.70)(c)	The used oil marketer must comply with either the used oil generator or transporter requirements.
	1 279 (279.70)(c)(1)	Does the marketer comply with standards for Used Oil Generators (use Used Oil Generator checklist to verify compliance)?
	1 279 (279.70)(c)(2)	Does the marketer comply with standards for Used Oil Transporter and Transfer Facilities (use Used Oil Transporter checklist to verify compliance)?
	1 279 (279.70)(c)(3)	Does the marketer comply with standards for Used Oil Processors and Re-refiners (use Used Oil Processors and Re-refiners checklist to verify compliance)?
	1 279 (279.70)(c)(4)	Does the marketer comply with standards for Used Oil Burners who burn Off-Spec Used Oil for Energy Recovery (use Burner/Blender checklist to verify compliance)?
	1 279 (279.72)(a)	Does the generator, transporter, processor/re-refiner, or burner have analyses to verify the used oil fuel meets the specification?
	1 279 (279.71)(a)	Does the used oil fuel marketer initiate shipments of off-specification used oil only to a used oil burner who has obtained an EPA ID Number?
	1 279 (279.71)(b)	Does the used oil fuel marketer initiate shipments of off-specification used oil only to a used oil burner who burns the used oil in either of the following: 1) an 'industrial furnace'; or 2) a 'boiler' identified under 279.61(a)(2)? [NOTE: A used oil-fired space heater is not classified or defined as a boiler or an industrial furnace under the provisions of HWRR.]
	1 279 (279.72)(b)	Are the used oil on-spec analysis records being kept for 3 years?
	1 279 (279.73)	Does the used oil fuel marketer have an EPA I.D. number?
	1 279 (279.74)(a)(1)	If the marketer has directed a shipment of off-spec used oil to a burner, does the marketer keep the name and address of transporter who delivers used oil to the burner?
	1 279 (279.74)(a)(2)	If the marketer has directed a shipment of off-spec used oil to a burner, does the marketer keep the name and address of burner who will receive the used oil?
	1 279 (279.74)(a)(3)	If the marketer has directed a shipment of off-spec used oil to a burner, does the marketer keep the EPA I.D. number of the transporter who delivers the used oil to the burner?
	1 279 (279.74)(a)(4)	If the marketer has directed a shipment of off-spec used oil to a burner, does the marketer keep the EPA I.D. number of the burner?
	1 279 (279.74)(a)(5)	If the marketer has directed a shipment of off-spec used oil to a burner, does the marketer keep a record of the quantity of the used oil shipped?
	1 279 (279.74)(a)(6)	If the marketer has directed a shipment of off-spec used oil to a burner, does the marketer keep the date of shipment?
	1 279 (279.74)(b)	Does the generator, transporter, processor/re-refiner, or burner who first claims the used oil meets the fuel specification keep a record of each shipment of used oil to an on-spec used oil burner?
	1 279 (279.74)(b)(1)	Do the on-spec records contain the name and address of facility receiving the shipment?
	1 279 (279.74)(b)(2)	Do the on-spec records contain the quantity of used oil fuel delivered?
	1 279 (279.74)(b)(3)	Do the on-spec records contain the date of the shipment or delivery?

	1 279 (279.74)(b)(4)	Do the on-spec records contain cross-reference to the record of used oil analysis or other information used to make the determination the oil meets the specification?
	1 279 (279.74)(c)	Are the on-spec records being kept for three years?
	1 279 (279.75)(a)	Has the used oil generator, transporter, or processor/re-refiner obtained the one-time written and signed notice from the burner before the first shipment of off-spec used oil fuel has been directed to a burner?
	1 279 (279.75)(a)(1)	Does the notice contain information certifying the burner has notified the State stating the location and general description of used oil management activities?
	1 279 (279.75)(a)(2)	Does the one-time notice contain information certifying that the burner will burn the off-spec oil only in an industrial furnace or boiler identified under 279.61(a)(2)?
	1 279 (279.75)(b)	Is there evidence that copies of the certification are being maintained for 3 years from the date the last shipment of used oil was shipped to the burner?
