*«« Wire hangers may be reusable by your local dry cleaner or a thrift shop. »»*

*«« Never mix antifreeze, solvents, paint thinner, or paint stripper with used oil. The businesses which accept used oil have strict government requirements about what they can accept.»»*

*«« Many recycling centers cannot accept green or blue glass. Contact your local center to determine if they accept glass, and if so, which colors are acceptable. Most centers do not accept glass such as door and window glass, windshield glass, and drinking glasses since those types of products are not made of the same materials as glass beverage containers. »»*

*«« Used oil cannot contain solvents or antifreeze. Check with your local community contacts about how to dispose or recycle antifreeze, solvents, paint thinner, and paint stripper. »»*

*«« Find ways to recycle at work. Some businesses generate large volumes of waste for which recycling options may be available. »»*

*«« Recycling in Wyoming can be economically challenging due to the distance to markets and the volumes we generate. Contribute to recycling in your community. »»*

*«« Paper and plastic bags can be used as liners in waste cans. »».*

*«« Your local library, thrift store, or used book store may accept paper and/or plastic grocery bags »»*

*«« Instead of using disposable paper or styrofoam cups when traveling or at work, use ceramic or reusable coffee cups. »»*
