The Wyoming Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) will meet on May 7, 2015 at 9:00 in the Auditorium of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, Basko Building, 2211 King Boulevard, Casper, Wyoming. The public is invited to attend and comment on proposed rules and guidelines presented to the WWAB for its consideration.

**Water Quality Division-** Beginning at 9AM, the Water Quality Division (WQD) will present proposed revisions to Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 24, Class VI Injection Wells and Facilities, Underground Injection Control Program. The objective of the proposed revisions is to incorporate grammar and punctuation corrections from the April 18, 2014 WWAB meeting and to incorporate liability insurance requirements and financial assurance requirements for carbon sequestration injection wells from W.S. 35-11-313 and from federal requirements found at 40 CFR 146.85. Written comments concerning the proposed changes to Chapter 24 may be directed to Kevin Frederick, Administrator, DEQ/WQD, Herschler Building 4-W, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002, or faxed to (307) 777-5973 prior to adjournment of the May 7, 2015 WWAB meeting . Email comments will not be considered. All written and oral comments received during the adjournment of the May 7, 2015 WWAB meeting will be considered.

**Solid and Hazardous Waste Division-** Following the Water Quality Division Presentation, the WWAB will consider, discuss, and make recommendations regarding grant requests for reimbursement to local governments conducting solid waste landfill monitoring pursuant to W.S. 35-11-521 for the Solid and Hazardous Waste Division. Following the reimbursement presentation, SHWD will present revisions to Solid Waste Guideline No. 25, "Annual Reports for Municipal Solid Waste Landfills with Lifetime Permits".
