for Coal Bed Methane Temporary Discharge

This Notice of Intent (NOI) is being filed for coverage under WDEQ's Coal Bed Methane General Permit for Temporary Discharge, issued September 4, 2012.

- Livestock Watering:** 6-month CBM discharge to be contained in stock reservoirs.
- Coal Bed Methane Water Characterization:** 15 days of discharge per sampled coal seam.

5. **Complete the attached Table 2.** Provide all information in the table for each proposed well.
6. **Attach a clear, legible topographic map** with the following features:
 - a. legend
 - b. well locations
 - c. outfall locations
 - d. water flow lines
 - e. treatment units (if utilizing treatment)
 - f. surface hydrology
 - g. Section, Township, Range, North Arrow
 - h. containment units (if applying under the livestock watering option)
7. **Provide the expected (estimated) total discharge flow rate from the wells at this facility, in million gallons per day (MGD).**
8. **List the names and addresses of all surface landowners of record** on whose property the discharges will occur, and/or containment units will be built. If surface ownership is federal or state, list surface lessee.
9. **If applying under the livestock watering option, attach the following:**
 - a. Table 3 (Reservoir Information)
 - b. Water balance describing all inputs and outputs to the containment units.
 - c. Letter from the landowner or lessee requesting the water. Letter must be dated and must include legal description (quarter/quarter, section, township, range) of the location for the requested discharge.
 - d. Copy of groundwater compliance approval letter or permit for the associated CBM reservoir(s). This approval is generated by WDEQ's Groundwater Pollution Control program, and is sent to the operator once a groundwater investigation review for the reservoir site(s) has been conducted.

10. If applying under the Coal Bed Methane water characterization category, list the following:

a. Name(s) of coal seams(s) to be sampled:

b. Anticipated start date for discharge: (Under this option, applicant is allowed up to 15 days of discharge per sampled coal seam, to occur within a 90-day period from the time of authorization.

*All permit applications must be signed in accordance with 40 CFR Part 122.22, “for” or “by” signatures are not acceptable.

Section 35-11-901 of Wyoming Statutes provides that:

“Any person who knowingly makes any false statement, representation, or certification in any application ... shall upon conviction be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.”

Wyoming Statute 35-11-312 was revised to require discharge permit fees be paid prior to permit issuance. Therefore, payment of permit fees must be accompanied with the application. Any application received without proper fee payment will be returned. Authorizations under this general permit will be issued for a maximum term of one year. Each authorization under this permit carries a flat fee of \$100.
