Agencies to hold Public Meeting

Cheyenne—On May 2, 2006, the Wyoming Air National Guard, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality will be holding a public meeting to provide residents with more information on an ongoing groundwater study.

The meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m. in Room 123 of the Laramie County Community College, Center for Conferences and Institutes.

A groundwater investigation detected substances used in the cleaning of aircraft parts, (Trichloroethene and Carbon Tetrachloride) in groundwater beneath the Wyoming Air National Guard facility and in the residential area immediately north of Dell Range Blvd.

According to Jane Francis, project manager for the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, the purpose of the meeting is to present up-to-date results of the ongoing investigation, to describe future phases of work, and to answer questions from concerned residents.

“The investigation has been going well and we hope to complete drilling at the site in late spring or early summer,” said Francis.
