

NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number 3891-06 to JL Hardy Construction (JL Hardy) on June 2, 2006. The NOV alleged that JL Hardy failed to pay WYPDES permit fees in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

On January 28, 2005 the DEQ had issued NOV and Order 3668-05 for failing to pay fiscal year 2004 fees. Fees were waived on February 8, 2005 since the facility was a small construction project as long as a Notice of Termination (NOT) was submitted. The NOT was processed on February 27, 2005. Instead of using an inactive date of June 30, 2004 (which would have prevented an invoice from being generated for fiscal year 2005), an inactive date for the project of February 27, 2005 was used. This resulted in the generation of the new invoice. With this letter, the DEQ has rescinded NOV Docket Number 3891-06. The DEQ apologizes for any inconveniences this may have caused.
