

NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation (NOV) Docket Number 3841-06 to Flying J Inc. (Flying J) on February 6, 2006. The NOV alleged that Flying J's produced water discharges resulted in exceeding permitted effluent limits at the Evanston, Wyoming truck stop. These are violations of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The NOV required Flying J to pay a total penalty of twenty thousand dollars and no cents (\$20,000.00) to the DEQ. Based on the May 26, 2006 letter and receipt of the \$20,000.00 penalty by DEQ, flying J has complied with the conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Docket Number 3841-06 and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.
