



**NOTICE OF VIOLATION**


**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:**


1. Sweetwater County Events Complex (Sweetwater) is the owner of a recreational vehicle (RV) park located in the south half of Section 10 of Township 19 North, Range 105 West in Sweetwater County, Wyoming.
2. Sweetwater submitted a permit to construct application to the Water Quality Division's (WQD) Lander Office on July 11, 2006, to expand the existing RV Park water distribution and sewage collection systems.
3. Wyoming Statute (W.S.) 35-11-301 (a) (iii) and (v) requires a permit for the construction of distribution and collection systems.
4. Sweetwater constructed and put into service expanded water distribution and sewage collection systems for the RV Park on or about July 27, 2006 without receiving a permit to construct from the WQD. This is a violation of W.S. 35-11-301 (a) (iii) and (v).
5. This Notice is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c) (i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) shall cause a written notice to be issued and served on the person alleged to be responsible;
6. Pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-11-901(a), any person who violates, or any director, officer or agent of a corporate permittee who willingly and knowingly authorizes, orders, or carries out the violation of any provision of the Environmental Quality Act (Act), or any rule, regulation, standard, or permit adopted hereunder or who violates any determination or order of the council pursuant to this act or any rule, regulation, standard, permit, license, or variance is subject to a penalty not to exceed ten thousand dollars and no cents (\$10,000.00) for each violation for each day during which the violation continues, a temporary or permanent injunction, or both a penalty and an injunction. The penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming. Nothing herein shall preclude the department from negotiating stipulated settlements involving the payment of a penalty, implementation of compliance schedules or other settlement conditions, in lieu of litigation.

NOTHING IN THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV) shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
