NOTICE OF VIOLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

- 1 of 7. Natrona County Fire Department is the applicant for a water distribution extension off the Hat Six Road, located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 5 of Township 33 North, Range 78 West in Natrona County, Wyoming. Worthington, Lenhart & Carpenter is listed as the engineer on the water distribution extension permit to construct application form. Installation & Service Company is the contractor of record on this water distribution extension project. These parties are referred to collectively as Natrona in this Notice of Violation (NOV).
- 2 of 7. Natrona submitted a permit to construct application form for the water distribution extension to the Water Quality Division (WQD) on October 13, 2006.
- 3 of 7. Wyoming Statute (W.S.) 35-11-301 (a) (v) requires a permit for the construction of a water distribution system.
- 4 of 7. WQD staff inspected the site on December 8, 2006, and observed construction had begun without a permit to construct being issued.
- 5 of 7. The construction of a water distribution system without a permit from the WQD is a violation of W.S. 35-11-301 (a) (v).
- 6 of 7. This NOV is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c) (i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) shall cause a written notice to be issued and served on the person(s) alleged to be responsible.
- 7 of 7. Pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-11-901(a), any person who violates, or any director, officer, or agent of a corporate permittee who willingly and knowingly authorizes, orders, or carries out the violation of any provision of the Environmental Quality Act (Act), or any rule, regulation, standard, or permit adopted hereunder or who violates any determination or order of the council pursuant to this act or any rule, regulation, standard, permit, license, or variance is subject to a penalty not to exceed ten thousand dollars and no cents (\$10,000.00) for each violation for each


day during which the violation continues, a temporary or permanent injunction, or both a penalty and an injunction. The penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming. Nothing herein shall preclude the department from negotiating stipulated settlements involving the payment of a penalty, implementation of compliance schedules, or other settlement conditions, in lieu of litigation.

NOTHING IN THIS NOV shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
