
Mr. Gray,


NOTICE OF VIOLATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

- 1 of 6. Tisdale Creek Ranch Inc. has a camper trailer park with a septic system located at 10277 South Highway 59 in Campbell County.
- 2 of 6. Tisdale Creek Ranch Inc. has not submitted a permit to construct application for the camper trailer park septic system.
- 3 of 6. Wyoming Statute (W.S.) 35-11-301 (a) (v) requires a permit for the construction of a septic system.
- 4 of 6. A representative of the Department of Environmental quality, Water Quality Division, visited the site on December 9, 2006 and observed an un-permitted septic system serving six camper trailers. This is a violation of W.S. 35-11-301 (a) (v).
- 5 of 6. This Notice of Violation is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c) (i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served on the person(s) alleged to be responsible.
- 6 of 6. Pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-11-901(a), any person who violates, or any director, officer, or agent of a corporate permittee who willingly and knowingly authorizes, orders, or carries out the violation of any provision of the Environmental Quality Act, or any rule, regulation, standard, or permit adopted hereunder or who violates any determination or order of the council pursuant to this act or any rule, regulation, standard, permit, license, or variance is subject to a penalty not to exceed ten thousand dollars and no cents (\$10,000.00) for each violation for each day during which the violation continues, a temporary or permanent injunction, or both a penalty and an injunction. The penalty may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming. Nothing herein shall preclude the department from negotiating stipulated settlements involving the payment of a penalty, implementation of compliance schedules or other settlement conditions, in lieu of litigation.

NOTHING IN THIS Notice of Violation shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this Notice of Violation be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
