NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation and Penalty Docket Numbers 3967-06 and 3987-06 on November 8, 2006, to Lance Oil & Gas Company, Inc. (Lance), a wholly owned subsidiary of Anadarko Petroleum Corporation (Anadarko). The NOV's alleged that Lance discharged coal bed methane (CBM) produced water to "waters of the state" in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The Notices of Violation required Lance to pay a total penalty of five thousand four hundred dollars and no cents (\$5,400.00) and submit a permit application to the DEQ requesting that WYPDES permit WY0049158 be modified. Based on the March 5, 2007 letter and receipt of the penalty, Lance has complied with the conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Docket Numbers 3967-06 and 3987-06 and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.
