

NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation (NOV) with an Order, Docket Number 4048-07, to the City of Casper (Casper) on April 3, 2007. The NOV was issued for conducting hydrant flushing activities causing soil erosion and transport of sediment into waters of the state. This discharge of pollution to a water of the state is a violation of W.S. §35-11-301 of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act.

An Order accompanied the NOV requiring City of Casper employees to attend training regarding water quality concerns and avoid hydrant flushing where erosion could be of concern. These requirements have been completed and accepted by the DEQ. Casper has achieved the conditions of the Order for Docket Number 4048-07 and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.
