
NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number 4254-08 on April 30, 2008 to Overland Resources, (Overland). The NOV alleged Overland had allowed crude oil to flow off site onto the adjacent property, northeast of the facility, with the potential to enter waters of the state by Overland Resources, Ltd. (Overland) in Albany County, Wyoming. The unauthorized discharge is in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The Notice of Violations required Overland to pay a total penalty of four thousand dollars and no cents (\$4,000.00) and submit in writing actions to be taken to achieve compliance with permit requirements to the DEQ. Based on information submitted by Overland and receipt of the penalty payment (received August 14, 2008), Overland has complied with the conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Docket Number 4254-08 and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with Overland in a proactive manner and is available for future meetings to discuss compliance issues or concerns regarding WYPDES permit requirements.
