NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number 4233-08 issued to General Chemical Energy Company (General Chemical), for the unauthorized discharge of 25,000 to 30,000 gallons of "water mixed with soda ash and trona ore impurities" into waters of the state. This is a violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQR).

The NOV required General Chemical to pay a total penalty of thirty five thousand dollars and no cents (\$35,000.00). Based on the September 24, 2008 letter, the clean up efforts implemented at the spill site, and receipt of the \$35,000.00 penalty by DEQ, General Chemical has complied with the conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Docket Number 4233-08 and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.
