NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE


The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division issued Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number **4542-09**, on August 25, 2009 to West End Water District. The NOV alleged that West End Water District had operated a public drinking water distribution system without the supervision of a certified chief operator in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5.

The Notice of Violation and Order ordered the completion of the following actions in order to comply with Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5:

1. Retain an appropriately certified chief operator;
2. Submit an operator designation form for the chief operator;
3. Retain a backup operator that either has appropriate certification or that will achieve appropriate certification within six months; and
4. Submit an operator designation form for the backup operator.

As of August 13, 2009, West End Water District has complied with the conditions of the Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number **4542-09**, and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.
