

**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number 4539-09 issued to Rush Creek Trailer Park (Rush Creek TP), for the unpermitted discharge of raw sewage and grey water from a septic system owned by Rush Creek TP. This is a violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

Based on the cleanup efforts implemented at the spill site, receipt of the follow up report and phone discussions with the owner of the facility the previous penalty associated with the violation has been waived. Information obtained regarding the release indicates it was not the owners fault by rather an upset condition caused by a broken pipeline resulting in the overflow of the tank. Rush Creek TP has complied with the conditions requested by DEQ for Docket Number 4539-09 and they find that all terms have been satisfied.
