**NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**


The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division issued Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number 4601-09, on January 27, 2010 to Horizon Park, LLC (Horizon Park). The NOV alleged that Horizon Park had operated a public drinking water distribution system without the supervision of a certified chief operator in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act and Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5.

The Notice of Violation and Order ordered the completion of the following actions in order to comply with Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5:

1. Retain an appropriately certified chief operator;
2. Submit an operator designation form for the chief operator;
3. Retain a backup operator that either has appropriate certification or that will achieve appropriate certification within six months; and
4. Submit an operator designation form for the backup operator.
5. Schedule a facility configuration inspection with the DEQ Southwest District Engineer.

As of March 19, 2010, Horizon Park has complied with the conditions of the Notice of Violation and Order, Docket Number 4601-09, and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.
