
NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation Docket Number **4658-10** on March 17, 2010 to Helis Oil and Gas Company (Helis). The NOV alleged that Helis had an unpermitted discharge of waste water produced from a ruptured injection line and was in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Act) and applicable Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WWQRR).

The Notice of Violations required Helis to pay a total of one thousand two hundred dollars and no cents (\$1,200.00) and submit in writing actions to be taken to achieve compliance with permit requirements to the DEQ. Based on reviewed information submitted by Helis and receipt of the penalty payment Helis has complied with the conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Docket Number **4658-10** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with Helis in a proactive manner and is available for future meetings to discuss compliance issues or concerns regarding WYPDES permit requirements.
